Brothers & Sisters in serving the people in our community who are in great need. Pastor Greg & Teresa have a good friend, Jennie Hiam, who attends Aldsersgate UMC and helps manage a ministry to the Evansville homeless community. Jennie has shared with us that they are always in need of donations as well as manpower in sorting and distributing the items they collect. They typically visit the Salvation Army, the Bus Station, the Youth Care Center at the Evansville Rescue Mission and the United Caring Shelter twice a week on Mondays and Thursdays. Sharing Jesus, supplies and helping direct people find directions for the services they need are some of their goals.

**From Jennie**: We use all of the following for our homeless ministry which we have entitled "Unto the Least of These"-taken from Matthew 25:40.


- Used, clean T-shirts, male and female, sizes medium, large, and extra-large
- Used, clean blankets-ALWAYS very much in need.
- New or used crew socks for men (the women wear these, too). Also ankle socks.
- Healthy breakfast bars-we make up treat bags and give one to each person we see.
- Hygiene items (can purchase several of these items at the Dollar Tree-VERY reasonably priced)-toothpaste, toothbrushes, deodorant, bars of soap, shampoo, razors, new combs, small bottles of hand sanitizer, rolls of toilet paper (one of the main items we provide for our people on the street, along with socks).
- Small Bibles/New Testaments-the Gideon size N.T. Small devotional items for reading such as "Our Daily Bread" and the "Upper Room".

If anyone in your church would like to provide any of the above items OR would like to go with us on either a Monday or a Thursday in our church van (10:45 a.m.-2 p.m.), we would love to have them. One person at a time only. They can contact me.


