EASTER MEANS ... EVERYTHING IS GOING TO BE OKAY

On April 16th, we will celebrate Easter. What a great day of worship it was for our church to be able to proclaim: He is Risen! He is Risen Indeed! Easter can be wrapped up in a simple statement: "Everything is going to be okay." Please consider how we can boldly make this statement in a world with so much turmoil.

As Jesus entered the world, it was in chaos — much as our world is today. When the angels announced His birth, they said, "Today, in the town of David, a Savior has been born to you; he is Christ the Lord" (Luke 2:11). Everything is going to be okay.

When John the Baptist announced the Christ saying — "Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!" (John 1:29) — He was saying, "Everything is going to be okay."

When Jesus encouraged His people to hold their heads up in a world of tribulation, He told them to cheer up: "I have told you these things so that in me you may have peace. The message that we as Christians should always proclaim to one and all, is the message of hope. Everything is going to be okay.



Easter AND the Annual EASTER EGG hunt is just around the corner. You can help in several ways:


- Pick up a bag of eggs (available in the hallway) and stuff each with candy.
