<sup>8</sup> And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death—even death on a cross!

If He had a wallet, your photo would be in it.

He sends you flowers every spring.

He sends you a sunrise every morning.

Whenever you want to talk, He listens.

2018 was a great year for MCC-we became parents!! The congregation joined together to sponsor two children from Haiti.


Daphnica Noel (bottom) will be 8 years old on June 8.



#### Christmas Eve Service at McJohnston Chapel was a very Special, Reflective service.


