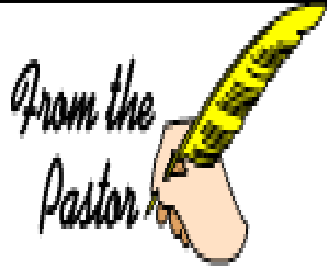


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Mission Statement

We have fun with this as the children do the flopping turkey wings and dance around to the lyrics. There are many reasons not to be a turkey, with the main one being that you get to keep your head on Thanksgiving.

But there are many more reasons not to be a turkey, and just say thanks, relating to the story of the ten lepers who received healing and only one came back to say thank you to Jesus. Likely I would have been counted in the nine who moved on so excited, relieved, and joyous to once again be counted as a human being and rejoining my family and friends. Therefore, I'm not going to beat up those nine who were healed and moved on to living, rather I want to remind us that God has saved, healed and restored all of us to life!

Children are typically reminded by parents and teachers to always speak two phrases: please and thank you. Let's set aside please, because it is typically spoken for something we want and maybe do not always need. However, thank you shows our gratification for what has been provided for us. For instance, when we pause at a meal and say a prayer which is often giving thanks for the meal that has been provided, do we realize the many people that God used in giving us this meal, such as the farmers, delivery people, processors, storekeepers, and cooks who prepared the meal? No. Most often we just say thank you for this food.
