May we drink deeply that our thirst may be quenched

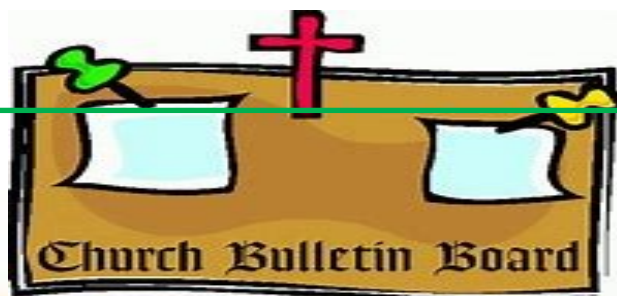
May your river continue to flow
