

Restoring Memory

There is a very popular television show on the History Channel called "American Pickers." On this show the two main characters, Mike and Frank, roam the country looking for American folklore, antiques, and miscellaneous items that not only still have value, they remind us of good times in the past. I have found that both young and old enjoy this show. While the these two do not always use the greatest of English (Frank might say "Me and Mike found...") and they might occasionally say words that I believe are inappropriate, they are not only providing entertainment, they are helping us have a memory.

Throughout the Old Testament, the people of God, the Jewish people, would slip into one bad situation after another because of their disobedience. God would send prophets to remind them of God and how God still and would always desire to be in relationship with them. All hope for being saved would almost be lost and suddenly someone would find their memory and because of God's grace God's people persevered.

Do we have memory today? Do we need a Mike and Frank to go around and remind us of what has value in our relationship with God? Deuteronomy 6:4-9 is that passage that reminds us that there is one God, who gives us His commands and we are to take them to heart, even impress them on our children. God's commands are not "antiques" from the past that we should continue to look beyond for something new. Rather because of God's grace that comes to us through the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ, God's ways are as alive and true today as they have always been.

I encourage you to take a look back in your life. Consider where God has been on your journey. Are there some things that you have left behind in your life, possibly because you have lost memory of God's purposes.

Remember to press on as encouraged in Philippians 2:12-13: continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling, for it is God who works in to will and to act according to His good purpose.


