Friends in Christ!

The Apostle Paul would start many of his letters with the greeting: "I thank God every time I remember you." What a joyous greeting that is! I Philippians 1: 4, he went on to say: "In all my prayers for all of you, I always pray with joy because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now, being confident of this, that He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus."

I begin this way because this month I want to share a theme that Paul might share and will call it: Cheers, Tears, and Jeers (you see this each Saturday in the local paper on the editorial page). So here we go, my first column of MCC cheers, tears, and jeers.

- <u>Cheers</u> for this beautiful day where the high temperature is supposed to be 80. "God said, "Let there be light. God saw the light was good, and he separated the light from the darkness." (Genesis 1:3)
